

Willington Stables donated by Isaac Godber to the National Trust



27th August 1945 – Isaac Godber, owner of Manor Farm, wrote offering the stables on the farm to the National Trust

16th November 1945 – a National Trust report recommended his offer be accepted and estimated the need for repairs at the stables costing £450

5th March 1947 - deed of gift of the stables from Isaac Godber to the National Trust with a right of access over the farm track and land adjoining the building

25th March 1947 – Isaac Godber added to the roll of National Trust benefactors



5th August 1975 – deed of gift of 0.26 acres of land adjoining the stables by Lord Godber, one of Isaac's sons and a well-known politician, to the National Trust with a right of access over the farm track
